Capital Assets: Suzy Bass recommended Mike Crowley to get our Capital Assets in order. He used to work for State Board of Accounts and was an auditor. Mr. Crowley charges \$120.00 per hour. Council would like to know if he has a rough idea of how many hours it would take him.
